Sophisticated, elegant & refreshing. Beautiful ingredients compliment each other without being overpowered. Tanqueray gin, lemon juice, orange bitters & a hint of sugar, topped with Lanson Black Label Champagne.

A Dockside creation made to reflect our cities most glorious days. 42 Below Feijoa vodka, peach tea, and Jules Taylor Sauvignon Blanc shaken with fresh lime, topped up with Ch'i and finished with fresh mint.

Lighthouse Gin Martini

Keep it local, keep it fresh - luckily gin is always in season. Made to your specifications - ask your bartender. Broken Shed Vodka can be used instead of Gin

J.D Single Barrel & Cherry Manhattan

A Manhattan variation with Jack Daniels Single Barrel Whiskey, Cherry Herring liqueur, and balanced with a dash of Absinthe and Orange Bitters.

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Pink Lighthouse

A silky, sumptuous gin based cocktail. Shaken with egg white & served in a martini glass. The tanginess of the lemon juice & Tuaca is offset by the sweetness of the raspberry.

Velvet Whiskey Sour

Inspired by the deer population of the Scottish Highlands. Hints of elderflower and chocolate add a unique balance to a classic recipe. Dalmore 12yo Scotch, Elderflower syrup, lemon juice, egg white and chocolate bitters.

Bloodied Mary

Our twist on a classic, named after a vagrant drinker named Mary who stumbled around the wharf over 100 years ago. Started with Wasabi vodka and three dashes of Tabasco, softened with a splash of Worcestershire sauce and finished with floated Devils Staircase Pinot Noir.

Berry Bramble

Everything a cocktail should be, full of subtle complex flavours and presented beautifully. Gin, lemon and sugar shaken into a rock glass primed with blueberries and finished with Blueberry Liqueur.

Baileys & Tennessee Honey White Choc Milk Punch

A smooth, creamy, delicious number with a slight hint of winter spice. Baileys, Jack Daniels Tennessee Honey Liqueur, Crème de Cacao, cream, egg white, nutmeg & spice.

Blue Mule

Make a good thing better; make it blue. A variation on a classic Moscow Mule, with an extra kick of sophisticated colour and flavour. Grey Goose L'Orange Vodka, Maraschino Liqueur, Blue Curaçao, lime juice, and ginger beer. Put an Asian spin on this and replace the L'Orange vodka and Blue Curaçao with Josh's Wasabi Vodka to create a **Tokyo Mule**

Strawberry Tide

Delicious fruity combination made for where the city meets the sea. Mt Gay Silver rum and Cointreau shaken with wild strawberry puree and fresh pineapple juice, finished with a single maraschino cherry.

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
